

Mail Order or Internet Sales of Prohibited Parts

Please read section 43A(3) of the Arms Act 1983 for laws relating to mail order or Internet sales of arms items or ammunition.

New Zealand has a new Firearms Registry. If you're a firearms licence holder, you have until 24 June 2028 to register your firearms. However, there are activating circumstances when you're required to provide information to the Registry within a shorter time frame. To find out how and when to register your firearms, go to firearmssafetyauthority.govt.nz/registry.

- 3. You may not take possession of any prohibited part unless you have:

 - a current firearms or dealer licence, and
 a current firearms endorsement appropriate to the item being purchased.
