
Please read first the steps in each section, then perform each step.












Handle Spokes 3 or 5 (Inside safe)



(1) Bolt Down Kit Concrete / Wood (Inside safe)

(I) 9V Alkaline Battery

<u>Step 1</u>

Locate the battery.

<u>Step 3</u>

Gently insert the battery up inside the keypad and slide the door closed.



Bottom of Keypad (Slide Battery Door - Closed)



Bottom of Keypad (Slide Battery Door - Open) <u>Step 2</u>

Slide the door open and connect the battery to the wire connection.

(I) 9V Alkaline Battery

<u>Step 1</u>

Locate the battery.

<u>Step 3</u>

Gently insert the battery up inside the keypad and replace the battery cover.





Bottom of Keypad (Remove screw)

<u>Step 2</u>

Remove the Phillips head screw from the battery cover located on the bottom of the keypad.

<u>Step 4</u>

Re-install the Phillips head screw in the battery cover. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN !




IMPORTANT !!

The temporary spoke provided is used to assist in opening the safe for the first time ONLY !

Installing the Temporary

Screw in the temporary spoke at the bottom of the handle hub.

Opening the safe for the first time

<u>Step 1</u>

Enter the factory pre-set code of:



Note !!

A beep will be heard after each number is pressed. A double beep will confirm the correct code entry.


<u>Step 2</u>

After entering in the factory code, a double beep will be heard. Then grasp the handle (as shown) and gently rotate clockwise within 4 seconds.



<u>Correct</u>

CAUTION !!



<u>Incorrect</u>

<u>Step 1</u>

Remove and discard the temporary spoke.



<u>Step 2</u>

Remove the box of spokes from the inside of the safe. Unpack and screw in each spoke into the handle hub.



Handle Spokes 3 or 5 (Inside safe)




3 Spoke Handle Shown

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Consumer ALERT !!

Your safe may have a "Anti-lock" device installed. This device is to prohibit the lock from locking and it needs to be removed so the safe operates properly. <u>This device is used for "Retail" display ONLY !!</u>



Device Removal !!

Remove the screw with the provided allen wrench under the label and plug the hole with the provided plastic hole plug.



Programming the lock

<u>Step 1</u>


Enter the factory pre-set code of: 1-2-3-4-5-6and open the door.

<u>Step 3</u>

Code Verification

IMPORTANT !!

The following must be done with the door in the open position with your locking bolts extended.



1. Enter in your personal 6 digit code (You will hear a double beep)

2. Entering in the wrong code will result in a long solid beep

3. Entering in the wrong code 4 times will result in the keypad shutting down for a 5 minute period. The battery must remain connected. Removing the battery WILL NOT over-ride the shutdown period.

<u>Step 2</u>

Programing

IMPORTANT !!

The following must be done with the door in the open position with your locking bolts extended.

<u>Please NOTE:</u> Between each step you have 4 seconds to proceed to the next step.

1. PRESS and hold the 0 until you hear a double beep (The RED light will come ON and remain ON)

2. Enter in the factory pre-set code of 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 (You will then hear a double beep)

3. Enter in your own personal 6 digit code. (You will then hear a double beep)

4. Enter in your personal 6 digit code - AGAIN (You will then hear a double beep)

5. The RED light will go out.





Programming the lock

<u>Step 1</u>

Enter the factory pre-set code of: 1-2-3-4-5-6and open the door.

<u>Step 3</u>

Code Verification

IMPORTANT !!

The following must be done with the door in the open position with your locking bolts extended

<u>NOTE:</u> If programming was done incorrectly, the code will remain 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6

Enter in your personal 6 digit code.
 (You will hear a double beep)

2. Entering in the wrong code will result in 3 beeps.

3. Entering in the wrong code 4 times will result in the keypad shutting down for a 5 minute period. The battery must remain connected. Removing the battery WILL NOT over-ride the shutdown period.

<u>Step 2</u>

Programing

IMPORTANT !!

The following must be done with the door in the open position with your locking bolts extended

<u>Please NOTE:</u> Between each step you have 4 seconds to proceed to the next step.

1. Enter in 0 - 0 - 0 - 0 - 0 - 0 until you hear a double beep

2. Enter in the factory pre-set code of 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 (You will then hear a double beep)

3. Enter in your own personal 6 digit code.(You will then hear a double beep)


4. Enter in your personal 6 digit code - AGAIN (You will then hear a double beep)



Un-bolting the safe from the pallet


<u>Step 1</u>

Locate the 3 black plastic caps on the inside carpeted base of the interior and remove them and set aside.



<u>Step 2</u>

Using a 9/16 wrench with an extension attached, remove all 3 lag screws.



Removing the safe from the pallet

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ATTENTION !!

The following is BEST performed with several individuals and is ONLY a suggested method. Granite Security Products will not be liable for any accidents, damages or injury that may occur.

<u>Step 1</u>

CAREFULLY !! Move the safe towards the back of the pallet.



<u>Step 2</u>

CAREFULLY !! Tip the safe back, and let the bottom edge of the safe contact the floor.



Step 3

CAREFULLY !! While the safe is tilted back, have another individual remove the pallet.



Step 4

CAREFULLY !! Tip the safe onto the floor



Limited Lifetime Warranty
This safe made by Granite Security Products, Inc. (GSP) comes with a limited lifetime warranty, begin- ning on the purchase date against defects in materials and workmanship as well as damage from a bur- glary attack or fire. The mechanical or electronic lock is warranted against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 1 year from the purchase date.
This non-transferable warranty applies to the original owner only, and proof of purchase is required to obtain service.
This warranty also provides a free replacement safe if the safe is damaged in a burglary attack or fire. Free replacement claims must be made in writing along with a timely police or fire department report. Photos of the damaged safe must accompany the replacement claim.
GSP may, at its discretion, repair or replace the damaged or defective safe on location. If it is damaged to the extent that it cannot be opened by normal means, then GSP, at their expense will have the safe opened by a skilled technician to retrieve the owner's belongings. If the safe is to be replaced, a comparable, current production model will be shipped freight collect to the owner. This warranty does not cover any cost to remove or install the safe.
This warranty does not cover neglect, misuse, or abuse. It also does not cover damage caused by tamper- ing with or altering of any part of the product. It also does not cover consumables such as batteries for the electronic lock. The safe must not be housed in an enclosed swimming pool area. The safe is to be located in an area which is climate controlled and is to be installed as instructed in the Owners Manual.
Certain exclusions to this warranty are: safes used in a commercial or industrial environment, water dam- age of any kind, paint finish, and loss or damage of personal property inside the safe. This warranty also does not apply to safes located outside the continental United States.
GSP provides this warranty in place of all other warranties and assurances whether expressed or implied. GSP accepts no liability for incidental or consequential damage or loss by anyone as a result of using this safe.

 FREE COMBINATION SEARCH: If your combination is lost or misplaced, you will receive FREE combination searches for 10 years after purchase date. Normal cost for a combination search is \$25.00

The serial number is located on the right front of the safe down by the ground and also on the back of the safe.
